DIGEST

Present law allows a nonresident full-time student enrolled in an accredited college or university in Louisiana to purchase a hunting and fishing license at a resident rate. Further provides that those students must be residents of a state that provides Louisiana residents who are full-time students attending an accredited college or university the same option to purchase a license at a resident rate.

Proposed law retains present law but removes the reciprocity provision that other states must offer Louisiana students attending an out-of-state college or university the option to purchase a hunting and fishing license at resident rates.

Effective August 15, 2010.
