HB No. 172

Abstract: Prohibits hunting game birds or wild quadrupeds with a firearm fitted with a laser sight or any sighting device designed to project a beam of light to the target or otherwise electronically illuminates the target.

Present law prohibits the taking or killing of game birds or wild quadrupeds with a firearm fitted with a silencer, infrared sight, electronic operated sight, a device designed to enhance night vision, or with an automatic shotgun holding more than three shells. Such shotguns may be used if fitted with a plug to reduce the capacity to three shells.

Proposed law retains present law except changes from "electronic operated sight" to "laser sight" and prohibits any sighting device designed to project a beam of light to the target or otherwise electronically illuminates the target.
