DIGEST

Peterson (SB 41)

Present law provides that the parcel fee shall expire eight years after its initial levy but may be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting on the proposition at an election. Any election to authorize the renewal of the fee shall be held only at the same time as the mayoral primary election in New Orleans. If the fee is renewed, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing such renewal, not to exceed eight years.

Proposed law retains present law but changes the election date that would authorize the renewal of the parcel fee from the mayoral primary to any regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans.

Effective July 1, 2010.
