DIGEST

Murray (SB 189)

Present law provides that the sheriff of Orleans parish shall file a copy of acts of sale of real property with the assessor within 15 days from the date of adjudication.

Present law provides that whoever violates the provision of present law shall be fined not more than \$50.00 or imprisoned for not more than 60 days, or both.

Proposed law removes both of these requirements from present law.

Present law provides that notaries public shall file and record all acts of sale or any other act evidencing a transfer of immovable property situated in Orleans Parish with the register of conveyances or recorder of mortgages or both and with the assessor.

Proposed law removes the requirement in Orleans Parish that notaries public shall file acts of sale of immovable property with the assessor.

Effective January 1, 2011.
