DIGEST

Riser (SB 479)

Proposed law removes provisions in Title 22, the Louisiana Insurance Code, that provide for lump sum payments by group insurers for death or permanent total disability to National Guardsmen activated by the governor or the president of the United States.

Proposed law is contingent upon passage and enactment into law of SB 245 which amends Title 29 to provide for payment of lump sum amounts for death or a qualifying permanent disability to National Guardsmen activated by the governor or president of the United States.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Insurance to the original bill.

1. Adds provision that makes bill contingent upon passage of SB 245 which provides for payment of death and disability benefits to National Guardsmen in Title 29.
