## DIGEST

Broome (SB 530)

Present law provides for the licensure and regulation of the practice of dentistry.

Proposed law provides that no provision in present law shall be construed to prohibit any person licensed under the provisions of present law from being an employee or independent contractor of a non-profit entity that meets the statutory, regulatory and program requirements for grantees supported under Section 330 of the Public Health Services Act (42 U.S.C. §245b) or its successor.

Proposed law further provides that it is procedural and not substantive, and should be applied retroactively as well as prospectively.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
