Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 913 by Representative Champagne

2 On page 3, delete lines 19 through 29 and on page 4, delete lines 1 through 5

4 On page 4, at the beginning of line 12, insert "1986"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 4, line 12, delete "of Louisiana for the year 1986"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 4, line 13, after "Fund" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 14 in its
9 entirety and insert a period "."

11 On page 5, line 18, change "legislation" to "law"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 6, at the beginning of line 14, insert "if"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 7

15 On page 6, line 15, after "or" insert "if"

17 On page 13, between lines 21 and 22, insert the following:

19 §2397. Distribution of revenue
20 The state treasurer shall each fiscal year deposit the revenues generated under
21 the provisions of this Chapter, from taxes applicable to the sale of reclaimed water,
22 or other sources as provided for by law into the Bond Security and Redemption
23 Fund. Out of the funds from such sources remaining in the Bond Security and
24 Redemption Fund after a sufficient amount is allocated from that fund to pay all
25 obligations secured by the full faith and credit of the state which become due and
26 payable within any fiscal year, the treasurer shall deposit an amount equal to one-
27 quarter of the revenues generated from the reclaimed water program into the
28 ~~Municipal Facilities Revolving Loan~~ Clean Water State Revolving Fund, enacted in
29 R.S. 30:2078 ~~30:2301~~, which shall be used for making grants to local governments
30 to finance primary waste treatment facilities; one-quarter into the Coastal Resources
31 Trust Fund, created in R.S. 49:214.40, and the remainder shall be used by the
32 Department of Natural Resources for the protection of groundwater resources. Use
33 of these funds shall be subject to an appropriation by the legislature."
