10 "**General staffing**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, line 3, delete "**compared**" and insert a period "." and delete line 4

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 7 and 8 and insert "**C. On the first day of the month following the**
15 **month in which the executive budget is submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee**
16 **on the Budget, the commissioner of administration shall provide a written report to the**
17 **Commission on Streamlining**"

30 **or part-time**"
