 24 **candidate. The statement shall be in writing, signed by the candidate making**
 25 **the statement, and shall include information relating to the felony conviction of**
 26 **the other candidate. The statement shall be submitted on the form provided by**
 27 **the secretary of state or on any form that contains the same information as**
 28 **required by the form prepared by the secretary of state."**

31 AMENDMENT NO. 1032 On page 2, line 20, after "**B.**" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:

1 **"Upon the timely receipt of the completed and signed statement provided**
2 **for in Subsection A of this Section, the qualifying official shall hand deliver or**
3 **transmit by facsimile a copy of the statement and a copy of the notice of**
4 **candidacy of the candidate alleged to have a felony conviction to the district**
5 **attorney whose jurisdiction includes the office for which the candidate has**
6 **sought to qualify. The copies of the statement and the notice of candidacy shall**
7 **be delivered or transmitted by the qualifying official to the district attorney on**
8 **the same day that the qualifying official received the statement. The district**
9 **attorney shall investigate and determine if an action objecting to the candidacy**
10 **of such person shall be filed pursuant to R.S. 18:495."**
