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Provides relative to nonresident combination lifetime hunting and fishing licenses for certain veterans who have been wounded or disabled during active duty. (8/15/10)

Present law allows a nonresident to obtain a combination lifetime hunting and fishing license for a fee of \$3,000. Proposed law retains present law and provides that any nonresident veteran who has been wounded or disabled during active duty and such injury is service-connected may obtain a combination lifetime hunting and fishing license for a fee of \$300. Such veteran must possess a valid Louisiana birth certificate and provide satisfactory proof of being a Louisiana resident for at least 10 years.

Effective August 15, 2010.
