 Provides local option elections for the adjustment of motor vehicle inspection fees in the nonattainment zone

Present law provides for an \$8 fee to be charged for each passenger vehicle emission inspection in the 5-parish ozone nonattainment area. The parishes which are subject to this additional fee are East Baton Rouge, West Baton Rouge, Iberville, Ascension and Livingston. Proposed law retains present law; and would require, upon adoption of a proposition approved by the voters of a nonattainment area parish, an additional \$7 charge for each passenger vehicle emission inspection. Proposed law provides that proposed law does not apply to Ascension and Livingston Parishes. Proposed law provides that no motor vehicle registered in a parish that adopts the charge authorized in proposed law is to be inspected in a parish other than the parish of registration. Proposed law would provide that collections from the \$7 additional charge (except those collections in East Baton Rouge Parish) be transferred to the parish or parish governing authority of that parish for development of mass transit systems; and provides that collections from the additional \$7 charge for motor vehicle emission inspections in East Baton Rouge be transferred to the Capital Area Transit System.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. No election costs are anticipated. The bill calls for local elections at the same time as the statewide election scheduled for November 2, 2010. The November 2, 2010 election is a statewide election, when all precincts in the state are scheduled to be opened. Costs for the November 2nd, as well as the statewide elections scheduled in August and September, are included in the FY 11 recommended budget.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation may, contingent upon the approval of a proposition in the parishes of East Baton Rouge, West Baton Rouge and Iberville, generate additional annual revenue collections of approximately \$2,181,500 in aggregate for those three parishes. This estimate is based on actual collections in FY 09 of \$3,462,872 from the existing \$8 charge on vehicle emission inspections in the 5-parish ozone nonattainment area.

Estimated annual collections from the \$7 charge in West Baton Rouge Parish (\$60,500) and Iberville Parish (\$121,000) would be transferred to each respective parish or parish governing authority for development of mass transit systems.

Estimated annual collections from the \$7 charge in East Baton Rouge, or \$2 million, would be transferred to the Capital Area Transit System.
