COASTAL PROTECT/RES FD. Provides in each fiscal year, at least \$200,000 but no more than seven percent of the federal revenues received by the state generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity may be used for administrative costs or fees. (8/15/10)

2 To enact R.S. 49:214.5.4(E)(4), relative to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund; to  
3 provide relative to funding and resource allocation; to provide that no more than  
4 seven percent of certain federal revenues generated from Outer Continental Shelf  
5 energy activity may be used for administrative costs or fees; to provide certain  
6 exceptions; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 49:214.5.4(E)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §214.5.4. Funding and resource allocation

12 **(4) In each fiscal year, at least two hundred thousand dollars but no**  
13 **more than seven percent of the federal revenues received by the state generated**  
14 **from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity may be used for**  
15 **administrative costs or fees. The provisions of this Paragraph shall not apply**  
16 **to the following:**

1. Provides a minimum amount of administrative costs or fees.
2. Changes "energy" to "oil and gas."
3. Deletes provision relative to "remaining percent" of revenues.
4. Provides certain exceptions.
