DIGEST

McPherson (SB 768)

Present law provides the procedure in removing an abandoned motor vehicle.

Proposed law provides that a tow truck operator called by the appropriate law enforcement agency to remove an abandoned motor vehicle will not lose its place in the rotation call list for such a recovery. Also requires law enforcement agencies to maintain records of the number of abandoned motor vehicles removed.

Effective August 15, 2010.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the original bill.

1. Deletes provision making the last titled owner of the motor vehicle presumptively responsible for the abandoned motor vehicle and for towing and storage costs unless adequate proof of sale was provided to the office of motor vehicles.
2. Requires law enforcement agencies to maintain records of the number of abandoned motor vehicles removed
