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Requires the commissioner of administration to disclose certain information concerning state contracts via the Internet

The proposed legislation requires the commissioner of administration to disclose certain information regarding state contracts on a website which posts reports of state spending. This information will include the contract amount, description and purpose of the contract, beginning and ending dates of the contract, name of the contracting agency, name of the contractor, and the city and state of the contractor.
