Amendments proposed by Representative Sam Jones to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 747 by Senator Jackson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "enact" and before "R.S. 49:220.10,"delete "R.S. 40:600.66(C), (D),
3 and (E) and"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 17 in their entirety and on page 2, delete lines 1 through
6 26 in their entirety

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, at the beginning of line 27, change "Section 2." to "Section 1."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 3, delete line 4 in its entirety and on line 5, delete "**favor of the Road Home**
11 **Corporation**" and insert "**state of Louisiana, for any claims arising in favor of the state**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 3, at the end of line 12, delete "**Road**" and at the beginning of line 13, delete
14 "**Home Corporation,**" and insert "**state,**"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 3, line 14, change "**Road Home Corporation**" to "**state**"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 3, delete line 16 in its entirety and insert "**B. The division of administration,**
19 **office of community development, is**"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 3, between lines 20 and 21, insert the following:

22 **"C. Road Home funding for those applicants listed in Subsection A of**
23 **this Section shall only be dispensed in accordance with revised program rules**
24 **for the Road Home Program, as reflected in a duly amended Action Plan**
25 **approved by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.**
26 **In the event that the United States Department of Housing and Urban**
27 **Development does not approve such amended Action Plan authorizing the use**
28 **of funds in accordance with the provisions of Subsection A of this Section,**
29 **Subsection A of this Section shall be without effect.**

30 **D. Nothing in this Section shall be deemed to create any right or cause**
31 **of action.**

1 Section 2. R.S. 49:220.10 enacted by this Act shall not be affected by Section 5 of
2 Act No. 5 of the 2006 First Extraordinary Session of the Louisiana Legislature, under which
3 the statutory authority for the Louisiana Recovery Authority would cease."
