Authorizes federal magistrate judges to perform marriage ceremonies for a specified time period

The proposed legislation retains present law and adds that any United States magistrate judge of the Western District, Eastern District, or Middle District may perform marriage ceremonies within this state and grants authority from October 1, 2010, though October 31, 2010.


