AN ACT

To enact R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3), relative to high school career options; to provide relative to certain examinations administered to students pursuing a career major curriculum and a career diploma; to require that construction of end-of-course examination questions reflect course content and method of instruction; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§183.3. Career major; description; curriculum and graduation requirements

**(3) The questions included in any end-of-course examination administered to students pursuing a career major program and curriculum as provided in this Section, the passage of which is required for high school graduation, shall be constructed in a manner that reflects course design and content and the method of instruction employed for the course.**

\* \* \*

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

1 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
2 effective on the day following such approval.
