

Existing law authorizes the Dept. of Revenue, the Dept. of Transportation and Development, and the Dept. of Environmental Quality to accept credit cards for payment of obligations owed to the state through the use of a third-party processor who collects a convenience fee to adequately cover transaction fees.

New law retains existing law and allows DPS&C and the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to accept credit cards for payment of obligations owed to the state through the use of a third-party processor who will collect a convenience fee to adequately cover transaction fees.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 25, 2010).
