

Existing law requires sex offenders and child predators to provide certain notifications to local law enforcement and the community.

Existing law provides certain penalties for the failure to comply with sex offender registration and notification requirements.

New law adds the posting of the number of the offender's physical address in a conspicuous place on the outside of the residence to the list of existing law notification requirements.

Effective August 15, 2010.
