

Prior law, relative to unemployment insurance, provided that employment records and reports shall be held confidential and not subject to subpoena, publication, or public inspection, except for public employees in performance of their public duties. Specified that the office of workers' compensation shall have access to answers to limited questions regarding whether benefits have been paid and the period of time paid.

New law removes the office of workers' compensation qualification regarding information in response to the limited questions regarding length of time benefits have been paid.

Effective August 15, 2010.
