

Prior law authorized any city court located in a city with a population of between 60,000 and 71,000 according to the most recent U.S. census to impose an additional \$5 fee as court costs in civil and criminal cases to be deposited in the general fund of the city and used for capital improvements for the building housing the city court.

New law authorizes the city court of Lake Charles to impose an additional \$5 fee as court costs in civil and criminal cases to be deposited in the general fund of the city and used for capital improvements for the building housing the city court.

Effective June 9, 2010.
