

Prior law provided that the parcel fee for the Oak Island Neighborhood Improvement District shall expire on December 31, 2014, but the fee may be renewed. Any election to authorize the renewal of the fee shall be held only at the same time as the mayoral primary election for the city of New Orleans. If the fee is renewed, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing such renewal, not to exceed eight years.

New law retains prior law but changes the date of election that would authorize the renewal of the parcel fee from the mayoral primary to any regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans under the Election Code.

Effective July 1, 2010.
