

Prior law provided that prior to the convening of each regular session, DOTD shall hold public hearings in each highway district for the purpose of reviewing priorities for the coming fiscal year. Required a report based on the testimony received at the hearings to be sent to the Joint Highway Priority Construction Committee.

New law provides that beginning on Oct. 1, 2010, and not later than Oct. 1 of every year thereafter, DOTD will provide to the Joint Highway Priority Construction Committee a proposed program of construction for the coming fiscal year.

New law provides that the Joint Highway Priority Construction Committee shall hold public hearings in each highway district for the purpose of reviewing priorities for a coming fiscal year. Requires a report based on the testimony received at the hearings be sent to DOTD.
