

If certain conditions are met, existing law exempts a principal who holds valid out-of-state certification as a principal, has experience as a principal in another state, and has completed one year of employment as a principal in a La. public school system from certain testing requirements relative to certification. New law adds one year of experience in La. as an assistant principal as an alternative to one year experience as a principal to the qualifications for such an exemption.

Effective August 15, 2010.
