CENSUS: Provides relative to provisions of Title 28 which are limited in applicability to political subdivisions or local areas meeting specified population characteristics (Item #8)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 28:53(G)(7)(introductory paragraph), 215.1, and

3 478(E)(introductory paragraph), relative to the provisions of Title 28 (Mental Health)

4 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 which are limited in applicability to

5 certain political subdivisions or local areas based upon population classifications; to

6 specify applicability to one or more political subdivisions or local areas; and to

7 provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 28:53(G)(7)(introductory paragraph), 215.1, and 478(E)(introductory
10 paragraph) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

11 §53. Admission by emergency certificate; extension

15 (7) As it relates to a parish which has a population between one hundred and
16 ninety-one thousand and one hundred ninety-two thousand residents, according to
17 the latest federal decennial census the parish of St. Tammany, all of the following

12 upon finding a qualified need for a community home in ~~any parish with a population~~

15 create an environment or atmosphere that will contradict the principle of integrated
16 community living, may authorize such community home within a one thousand foot
17 radius of another community home after meeting the following requirements:

Abstract: Updates applicability of provisions in Title 28 as a result of the 2010 census.

Proposed law, contained in Title 28 (Mental Health) of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, legislates with regard to classifications of parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas according to population by enacting local bills to limit the application of laws based upon specific classifications to one or more parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas, as follows:
