Abstract: Updates applicability of provisions in Title 25 as a result of the 2010 census.

Proposed law, contained in Title 25 (Libraries, Museums, and other Scientific and Cultural Facilities) of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, legislates with regard to classifications of parishes, municipalities, or other political subdivisions or local areas according to population by limiting applicability to one or more political subdivisions or local areas, as follows:

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to the original bill.

1. Adds provision relative to exemption from limitation on creation of historic preservation districts.
