DIGEST

Murray (SB 19)

Proposed law contained in Title 23 (Labor and Workers' Compensation) of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, legislates with regard to the classification of municipalities according to population by enacting local bills to limit the application of laws based upon specific classifications to one of more municipalities by adjusting the population ranges affected by the 2010 census, and by repealing certain provisions based upon certain population classification ranges, as follows:
