Abstract: Provides relative to the maximum work hours required of certain employees of the Lake Charles Fire Dept. in a certain time period.

Present law provides that the maximum work hours required by persons employed or engaged full time by municipalities or municipal fire departments or by parish or parish fire departments or fire protection districts as operators of fire alarm systems in any one calendar week is 42 hours.

Proposed law provides that notwithstanding present law, the maximum work hours required by persons employed or engaged full time by the Lake Charles Fire Dept. as operators of fire alarm systems in any 14-day work cycle is 84 hours.
