HB No. 470

Abstract: Creates mechanism whereby a motor vehicle title can be received on an expedited basis and provides for fees for such service.

Present law provides for certain fees received by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to be deposited into the Office of Motor Vehicles Customer Service and Technology Fund.

Proposed law retains present law and provides for any fees charged by the DPS&C, office of motor vehicles, in conjunction with expedited motor vehicle titles to be deposited into the Office of Motor Vehicles Service and Technology Fund.

Proposed law provides that any request to convert an existing paper title to an electronic title shall be forwarded to the department by the federally insured depository institution, finance company, lending institution, or other lender through its interface with its designated public tag agent. Upon receipt of such a request the department shall convert the paper to an electronic title at a charge to the lender not to exceed \$1.50 per title. This charge shall be forwarded to the state treasurer for deposit into the Office of Motor Vehicles Customer Service and Technology Fund. The public tag agent fee shall not exceed \$3 per title conversion request.

Proposed law directs the DPS&C, office of motor vehicles, to establish an expedited processing procedure for the receipt of applications and the issuance of certificate of title for motor vehicles.

Proposed law provides that each certificate of title issued pursuant to a procedure established by an expedited processing procedure be an additional \$10 to the \$18.50 charged for the title itself. The additional \$10 shall be forwarded to the state treasurer for deposit into the Office of Motor Vehicles Customer Service and Technology Fund.
