
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Original House Bill No. 370 by Representative Jane Smith

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, after "bonds;" and before "and" insert "to provide for effectiveness;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 16, after "bonds" and before the period "." insert "as well as pay amounts of
5 ongoing expenses associated with the administration, maintenance, or evaluation of the
6 bonds issued for Interstate 49 North and Interstate 49 South"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 3, at the end of line 6, delete "unclaimed property"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 3, at the beginning of line 7, delete "revenues"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 3, line 8, after "bonds" and before "monies" delete "and may further pledge"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 3, line 20, after "receipts" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and from
15 the beginning of line 21, delete "fiscal year" and insert "which have been deposited into the
16 Unclaimed Property Leverage Fund"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 3, at the end of line 21 after "service" and before "on" insert "and all related costs
19 and expenses associated therewith"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 3, at the end of line 22, insert the following:

22 "At no time shall bond payments securitized by unclaimed property receipts in the
23 Unclaimed Property Leverage Fund exceed fifteen million dollars per year."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 9

25 On page 8, after line 5, insert the following:

26 "P.(1) The provisions of this Section shall become null, void, and of no
27 effect on the date that all bonds issued by the commission are paid or deemed paid
28 in full and are no longer considered outstanding or the Interstate 49 project is deemed
29 completed by the Department of Transportation and Development, whichever is
30 later."

1 (2) If bonds for this project are not sold by December 31, 2013, the
2 provisions of this Section shall become, null, void, and of no effect on January 1,
3 2014."
