Designates La. Hwy. 34 from La. Hwy. 546 to Kings Lake Road as the "Corporal J.R. Searcy Memorial Highway".

Designates the section of U.S. Hwy. 51 from the intersection of La. Hwy. 38 to the Mississippi state line as the "Trooper Rudolph H. Miller Memorial Highway".

Designates the section of La. Hwy. 118 from Florien to Kisatchie as the "Louisiana Maneuvers and Purple Heart Memorial Highway".

Designates the section of La. Hwy. 749 from the intersection of West Martin Luther King Drive to the intersection of La. Hwy. 167 as the "Griffin Pat Miller Memorial Highway".

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
