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**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to Original House Bill No. 335 by Representative Brossett

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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 4, insert "abandoned or blighted"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 5, after "improvements" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning  
5 of line 6, delete "property by the tax sale purchaser;" and insert in lieu thereof "required to  
6 bring the property into compliance with one or more municipal code ordinances; to provide  
7 relative to the maximum amount of reimbursement;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, line 1, after "B." and before "Notwithstanding" insert "(1)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, line 2, after "improvements to" delete the remainder of the line and insert  
12 "abandoned or blighted property, as defined in R.S. 19:136.1, in order to bring the property  
13 into compliance with one or more municipal code ordinances prior"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 2, line 4, after "improvements" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 5  
16 and 6 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof "required to bring the property into  
17 compliance with any such ordinances. The maximum amount of reimbursement for  
18 improvements shall be fifteen hundred dollars for abandoned property and three thousand  
19 dollars for blighted property. The maximum amount shall be per property per year.

20 (2) In order to receive reimbursement for the costs of improvements, the tax  
21 sale purchaser shall be required to file an affidavit and receipts in the mortgage  
22 records of the parish documenting the costs of such improvements within sixty days  
23 after receiving notice of redemption."
