

SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Local and Municipal Affairs to Engrossed House Bill No. 353 by Representative Arnold

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 46:1095(B)(1)" delete the remainder of the line and insert in
3 lieu thereof "and (C) and 1097(A), relative to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "district;" delete the remainder of the line and insert "to provide
6 relative to effective dates;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 11, after "R.S. 46:1095(B)(1)" delete remainder the remainder of the line and
9 delete line 12 and insert "and (C) and 1097(A) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
10 follows:"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, line 10, after "Each" strike "commissioner" and insert "member"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 26 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

15 "C.(1) The members serving pursuant to Paragraph (B)(1) shall serve
16 staggered initial terms with two appointments for one year, two for two
17 years, two for three years, and one for four years. Thereafter, such
18 commissioners shall serve four-year terms.

19 (2) The members member serving pursuant to ~~Paragraphs (B)(1) and~~
20 ~~(2) Paragraph (B)(2)~~ of this Section shall serve at the pleasure of the chief
21 executive officer of the parish.

22 ~~(2)(3)~~ (3) The members serving pursuant to Paragraphs (B)(3) through
23 (7) of this Section shall serve during their terms of office.

24 ~~(3)(4)~~ (4) Any vacancy in the membership of the commission occurring
25 by reason of the expiration of term of office, death, resignation,
26 disqualification, or otherwise shall be filled in the same manner as the
27 original appointment within thirty days of such vacancy. If the appointing
28 authority fails to fill the vacancy within thirty days of such vacancy, the
29 remaining members of the commission shall appoint an interim successor to
30 serve on the commission until the position is filled by the appointing
31 authority."

32 AMENDMENT NO. 6

33 On page 2, between lines 27 and 28, insert the following:

34 "§1097. Commission; powers, duties, responsibilities, limitations
35 A. The commission and district shall have all the general powers,
36 duties, functions, and responsibilities of a hospital service district created
37 under the general provision of Part I of this Chapter. Each commission
38 created under this Part may construct or acquire a new general hospital
39 facility in Orleans Parish or renovate an existing general hospital facility in
40 Orleans Parish and provide for the operation of such facility.

1 Section 2. All appointments of the members of the Orleans Parish
2 Hospital Service District currently appointed pursuant to R.S. 46:1095(B)
3 shall be terminated and such seats shall be declared vacant on the effective
4 date of this Act and new appointments shall be made in accordance with the
5 provisions of this Act. Nominations for appointments pursuant to new law
6 R.S. 46:1905(B)(1)(a), (b) and (c) shall be due to the governing authority of
7 the city of New Orleans by January 1, 2012."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 7

9 On page 2, line 28, change "Section 2." to "Section 3."
