HOUSE BILL NO. 162

BY REPRESENTATIVE AUSTIN BADON AND SENATOR WILLARD-LEWIS

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 33:9091.18, relative to Orleans Parish; to create the Pressburg East
3 Neighborhood Improvement and Security District within the parish; to provide
4 relative to the purpose, governance, and powers and duties of the district; to provide
5 for the imposition of a parcel fee and for the use thereof; and to provide for related
6 matters.

7 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
8 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
9 Louisiana.

10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

11 Section 1. R.S. 33:9091.18 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

12 §9091.18. Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and Security District

13 A. Creation. There is hereby created within the parish of Orleans, as more
14 specifically provided in Subsection B of this Section, a body politic and corporate
15 which shall be known as the Pressburg East Neighborhood Improvement and
16 Security District, referred to in this Section as the "district". The district shall be a
17 political subdivision of the state as defined in the Constitution of Louisiana.

18 B. Boundaries. The district shall be comprised of the area of the parish of
19 Orleans lying within the following perimeter: bounded on the north side by the north
20 side of Dwyer Road, bounded on the west side by the west side of Read Boulevard,
21 bounded on the south side by the south side of Chef Menteur Highway, and bounded
22 on the east side by a line parallel to the east side of Nighthart Street which extends
23 in a northerly direction to its intersection with the north side of Dwyer Road and

1 which extends in a southerly direction to its intersection with the south side of Chef
 2 Mentour Highway.

3 C. Purpose. The district is established for the primary object and purpose of
 4 promoting and encouraging the beautification, security, and overall betterment of the
 5 district.

6 D. Governance. (1) The district shall be governed by a board of
 7 commissioners, referred to in this Section as the "board", consisting of seven
 8 members as follows:

9 (a) The president of the Pressburg East Homeowners/Neighborhood
 10 Association, referred to this Section as the "association".

11 (b) The governing board of the association shall appoint three members, two
 12 of whom may be members of the board.

13 (c) The member of the city council of New Orleans whose district
 14 encompasses all or the greater portion of the area of the district shall appoint one
 15 member.

16 (d) The member of the Louisiana House of Representatives whose district
 17 encompasses all or the greater portion of the area of the district shall appoint one
 18 member.

19 (e) The member of the Louisiana Senate whose district encompasses all or
 20 the greater portion of the area of the district shall appoint one member.

21 (2) All members shall be residents and qualified voters of the district.

22 (3)(a) The board member serving pursuant to Subparagraph (1)(a) of this
 23 Subsection shall serve on the board during his term of office as president of the
 24 association.

25 (b) Board members serving pursuant to Subparagraph (1)(b) of this
 26 Subsection shall serve three-year terms after serving initial terms as follows: one
 27 member shall serve an initial term of one year, one member shall serve an initial
 28 term of two years, and one member shall serve an initial term of three years, as
 29 determined by lot at the first meeting of the board.

1 (c) Each member serving pursuant to Subparagraphs (1)(c) through (e) of
2 this Subsection shall serve on the board during the term of office of his respective
3 appointing authority.

4 (4) Vacancies resulting from the expiration of a term or for any other reason
5 shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term in the manner of the original
6 appointment.

7 (5) The members of the board shall select from among themselves a
8 president and such other officers as they deem appropriate. The responsibilities of
9 the officers shall be as provided by the bylaws of the board.

10 (6) The members of the board shall serve without compensation.

11 E. Powers and duties. The district, acting through its board of
12 commissioners, shall have the following powers and duties:

13 (1) To sue and be sued.

14 (2) To adopt, use, and alter at will a corporate seal.

15 (3) To receive and expend funds collected pursuant to Subsection F of this
16 Section and in accordance with a budget adopted as provided by Subsection G of this
17 Section.

18 (4) To enter into contracts with individuals or entities, private or public, for
19 the provision of security patrols in the district.

20 (5) To purchase items and supplies which the board deems instrumental to
21 achieving the purpose of the district.

22 (6) To perform or have performed any other function or activity necessary
23 for the achievement of the purpose of the district.

24 F. Parcel fee. The New Orleans City Council is hereby authorized to impose
25 and collect a parcel fee within the district subject to and in accordance with the
26 provisions of this Subsection.

27 (1) The amount of the fee shall be as requested by duly adopted resolution
28 of the board. The fee shall be a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed
29 two hundred dollars per year for each parcel.

30 (2)(a) The fee shall be imposed on each parcel located within the district.

1 **(b) For purposes of this Section, "parcel" means a lot, a subdivided portion**
2 **of ground, an individual tract, or a "condominium parcel" as defined in R.S.**
3 **9:1121.103.**

4 **(c) The owner of each parcel shall be responsible for payment of the fee.**

5 **(3)(a) The fee shall be imposed only after the question of its imposition has**
6 **been approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting on the**
7 **proposition at an election held for that purpose in accordance with the Louisiana**
8 **Election Code. The amount of the fee may be changed by duly adopted resolution**
9 **of the board, not to exceed the maximum amount authorized in this Subsection. No**
10 **other election shall be required except as provided by this Paragraph.**

11 **(b) If approved, the fee shall expire on December 31, 2015, but the fee may**
12 **be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district voting**
13 **on the proposition at an election as provided in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph.**
14 **If the fee is renewed, the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as provided in the**
15 **proposition authorizing such renewal, not to exceed eight years.**

16 **(4) The fee shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ad**
17 **valorem taxes on property subject to taxation by the city are collected.**

18 **(5) Any parcel fee which is unpaid shall be added to the tax rolls of the city**
19 **and shall be enforced with the same authority and subject to the same penalties and**
20 **procedures as unpaid ad valorem taxes.**

21 **(6)(a) The proceeds of the fee shall be used solely and exclusively for the**
22 **purpose and benefit of the district; however, the city may retain one percent of the**
23 **amount collected as a collection fee.**

24 **(b) The city of New Orleans shall remit to the district all amounts collected**
25 **not more than sixty days after collection.**

26 **G. Budget. (1) The board of commissioners shall adopt an annual budget**
27 **in accordance with the Louisiana Local Government Budget Act, R.S. 39:1301 et**
28 **seq. The budget and all amendments shall be subject to the approval of the New**
29 **Orleans City Council.**

1 (2) The district shall be subject to audit by the legislative auditor pursuant
2 to R.S. 24:513.

3 H. Miscellaneous provisions. (1) It is the purpose and intent of this Section
4 that the additional law enforcement or security personnel and their services provided
5 for through the fees authorized in this Section shall be supplemental to and not in
6 lieu of personnel and services provided in the district by the New Orleans Police
7 Department.

8 (2) If the district ceases to exist, all funds of the district shall be transmitted
9 by the board to the city of New Orleans, and such funds, together with any other
10 funds collected by the city of New Orleans pursuant to this Section, shall be
11 maintained in a separate account by the city and shall be used only to promote,
12 encourage, and enhance the security, beautification, and overall betterment of the
13 area included in the district.
