

Existing law authorizes the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) to make payments for the care and treatment of youth who are assigned to the custody of the department and placed in nonstate-operated treatment programs.

New law retains existing law.

New law provides that DPS&C may make payments for the care and treatment of youth who are placed on probation or parole and placed in nonstate-operated treatment programs.

Effective August 15, 2011.
