

Existing law provides that in the City Court of Alexandria and the City Court of Pineville, the civil jurisdiction is concurrent with the district court in cases where the amount in dispute, or the value of the property involved, does not exceed the amount triggering the right to demand a jury trial.

Prior law provided for the civil jurisdictional amount of \$25,000 in the City Court of Ruston.

New law provides that in the City Court of Ruston, the civil jurisdictional amount in dispute does not exceed the amount that triggers the right to demand a jury trial (\$50,000 exclusive of interest and costs).

Effective August 15, 2011.
