

Existing law allows certain exceptions to the sterilization requirements for dogs and cats sold or released for adoption from public or private animal shelters.

Prior law provided that sterilization requirements did not apply to a dog or cat when the adopter executed a written agreement of obligation for the care of the adopted pet and any offspring and paid any fees set forth by the releasing agency.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective August 15, 2011.
