
The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Jay R. Lueckel.

DIGEST

Present law provides for the allocation of certain tax money in the "Two Percent Fire Insurance Fund". A portion of such proceeds are distributed to each parish on the basis of population shown by the latest federal census or as determined by the Division of Business and Economic Research of Louisiana Tech University under the latest federal-state cooperative program for local population estimates.

Proposed law retains present law relative to the allocation but replaces La. Tech University with the LSU Agriculture Center Department of Agricultural Economics and Agribusiness for the purposes of the federal-state cooperative program for local population estimates.

Present law provides for the distribution of monies in the Parish Transportation Fund to the several parish governing authorities on a per capita basis in population categories, based on the population as determined by the latest federal decennial census or by the Division of Business and Economic Research of Louisiana Tech University under the latest federal-state cooperative program for local population estimates, whichever is more recent.

Proposed law retains present law relative to the distribution categories but replaces La. Tech University with the LSU Agriculture Center Department of Agricultural Economics and Agribusiness for the purposes of the federal-state cooperative program for local population estimates.

Effective July 1, 2012.
