SENATE BILL NO. 513

BY SENATOR CROWE

ADMINISTRATION DIVISION. Restricts the division of administration from making certain expenditures to companies or entities which engage in the production of obscene or pornographic material. (8/1/12)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 39:249, relative to the expenditure of state funds; to prohibit certain
3 expenditures by the division of administration; to prohibit the approval of certain
4 expenditures; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 39:249 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 **§249. Prohibition on expenditures for obscene or pornographic materials**

8 **The division of administration shall not expend monies, or approve the**
9 **expenditure of any monies, to any individual, entity, company, corporation,**
10 **association, organization or subsidiary of any corporation, which is required to**
11 **maintain records pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §2257.**

DIGEST

Proposed law provides that the division of administration shall not spend monies, or approve the expenditure of monies, to any individual, entity, company, corporation, association, organization, subsidiary of any corporation which is required to maintain records in order to protect children from sexual exploitation, sexual abuse, or molestation in the production of such obscene or pornographic materials.
