SENATE BILL NO. 546

BY SENATOR PEACOCK

COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS. Permits non-resident vendors of recreational products to exhibit at recreational products and trade shows. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 32:1254(O), relative to the distribution and sale of motor vehicles; to provide
3 for licensure of dealers; to provide for an exception for non-resident dealers of
4 recreational products; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 32:1254(O) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §1254. Application for license; requirements for licensure; contents; licenses;
8 franchise filings; **exception**

9 * * *

10 **O. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the Motor Vehicle**
11 **Commission shall allow non-resident exhibitors to participate and offer for sale**
12 **recreational products at recreational product shows and trade show exhibitions**
13 **taking place in this state. Any rule or regulation of the commission in conflict**
14 **with these provisions existing upon the effective date of this Subsection shall be**
15 **null and void.**

16 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
17 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

1 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
2 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
3 effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Proposed law requires the Motor Vehicle Commission to allow non-resident exhibitors to participate and offer for sale recreational products at recreational product shows and trade show exhibitions taking place in La.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
