1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "30:2351.53" and insert "30:2351.1(6) and 2351.53" and delete  
3 "public and"

5 On page 1, line 3, delete "non-public schools" and insert "child-occupied facilities" and  
6 change "issues" to "hazards"

8 On page 1, line 4, delete "students attending" and insert "children enrolled at"

10 On page 1, line 5, change "schools" to "facilities"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 1, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

15 "§2351.1. Definitions

16 As used in this Chapter, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following  
17 terms have the following meanings:

19 **(6) "Child-occupied facility" means a building or portion of a building**  
20 **or common area, other than the child's principal residence, constructed prior**  
21 **to 1978, and meets one of the following:**

22 **(a) Is visited regularly by the same child, who is six years of age or**  
23 **younger, on at least two different days within any week, provided that each**  
24 **day's visit lasts at least three hours, that the combined weekly visits last at least**  
25 **six hours, and the combined annual visits last at least sixty hours. Examples of**  
26 **child-occupied facilities include, but are not limited to, public and non-public**  
27 **elementary schools, day care centers, parks, playgrounds and community**  
28 **centers.**

29 **(b) Has been determined by the department, in conjunction with the**  
30 **state health officer, to be a significant risk because of its contribution to lead**  
31 **poisoning or lead exposure to children who are six years of age or younger.**

32 **(c) Is a child-occupied unit and common area in a multi-use building.**

6 On page 1, line 11, delete "**secondary schools in the state**" and delete "**issues**" and insert  
7 "**hazards**"

12 On page 1, line 13, delete "**grounds**"

15 "**within ninety days of receipt of reports of lead hazards, lead abatement**  
16 **activities or any lead testing performed to the secretary of the Department of**  
17 **Environmental Quality, the state health officer, and the secretary of the**  
18 **Department of Health and Hospitals. A copy of the notification shall be**  
19 **displayed in a prominent location at the child-occupied facility.**"

21 On page 1, delete line 15, and insert "**B. All child-occupied facilities shall**"

23 On page 1, line 16, delete "**enrolled student**" and insert "**child enrolled at the facility**"
