DIGEST

Long (SB 249)

Proposed law re-creates the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries for four more years. Changes the termination date from July 1, 2013, to July 1, 2017.

Proposed law provides for the general re-creation of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries and its statutory entities, effective June 30, 2012, in accordance with the sunset law. Supersedes the provisions of the sunset law which set out the procedure for review and recreation and which require a separate bill to re-create each statutory entity within the department along with additional provisions. July 1, 2017 is the new termination date, and termination would begin July 1, 2016, unless the department is again re-created.

Effective June 30, 2012.
