DIGEST

Nevers (SB 745)

Proposed law requires an election to be called for the purpose of consolidating two or more school systems in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution, pursuant to an act by the legislature or a resolution adopted by each of the affected school boards. Provides that consolidation of two or more school systems shall be subject to the approval by a majority of the electors voting, in each school system affected, in the election held for this purpose.

Effective August 1, 2012.
