CHILDREN'S CODE

RE NO IMPACT See Note

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Provides for academic plan for children committed to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. (gov sig)

Proposed legislation provides that Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPSC) shall, within 30 days of a child's adjudication to a secure care facility, assess the child's academic grade level using a research based diagnostic. Proposed legislation requires the department to develop an academic plan based upon the grade level diagnostic test, past academic performance, the individualized education plan or individual learning plan, and the length of time the child will be in secure care. Proposed legislation provides for the department to provide a copy of the academic plan to the child's parents or guardian, district attorney and counsel for the child at the time the academic plan is submitted to the court. Proposed legislation further provides for the department to submit a report on the child's academic progress in the quarterly report to the court. Proposed legislation provides that upon the child's discharge from the department's custody, the department will provide a copy of the child's academic plan and all progress reports to the child's parents or guardian and the school where the child enrolls upon written request.
