Barras HB No. 497

Abstract: Authorizes the city of New Iberia to grant ad valorem tax exemption contracts to owners of property annexed by the city after Jan. 1, 2013.

<u>Present constitution</u> authorizes the levy of ad valorem tax by various units of local government.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> retains <u>present constitution</u> and authorizes the granting of ad valorem tax exemption contracts by the city of New Iberia for property annexed by the city after Jan. 1, 2013.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> provides that a contract shall grant to the owner of the annexed property a tax exemption for up to five calendar years, which may be renewed for an additional five years.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> requires that all property exempted pursuant to a contract be listed on the assessment rolls, but no taxes shall be collected thereon during the period of exemption; however, the exemption shall in no way affect or impair the security of any bonds payable from the proceeds of a tax.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> authorizes the legislature to provide by law for implementation of <u>proposed constitution</u>.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 6, 2012.
