DIGEST

Long (SB 685)

Proposed law requires a teacher to schedule at least two parent-teacher conferences during the first semester of each school year.

Proposed law requires the governing authority of each elementary and secondary school to adopt rules relative to the failure of the parent or guardian of the child to attend at least one scheduled parent-teacher conference.

Effective August 1, 2012.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Changes the entity required to adopt rules relative to the failure of the parent or guardian of the child to attend at least one scheduled parent-teacher conference from the local school board to the governing authority of each elementary and secondary school.
