

Prior law created the Louisiana Property and Casualty Commission with the functions, duties, and responsibilities of reviewing and examining the availability and affordability of property and casualty insurance in the state. Provides that members serve two-year terms.

New law retains prior law and adds a representative of the Louisiana Surplus Line Association and the Deputy Commissioner for Consumer Advocacy to the membership of the commission.

Effective August 1, 2012.
