

Prior law provided that a baccalaureate degree program shall not require more than the number of credits established by the Board of Regents for degree completion without approval from the board.

New law modifies prior law and instead provides that a baccalaureate degree program shall not exceed 120 credit hours without approval from the Board of Regents, except for degree programs which require additional credit hours to meet certification or accreditation requirements.

Effective August 1, 2012.
