**SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to Original Senate Bill No. 18 by Senator Ward

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, delete "sanitary code" and insert "Sanitary Code"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, delete "to provide for the promulgation of rules and regulations;" and  
5 insert:

6 "to provide for annual registration with the Department of Health and Hospitals; to provide  
7 for a public registry; to require a certificate from the National Registry of Food Safety  
8 Professionals; to provide for penalties;"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, line 8, after "consumption" insert "; public registry; certificate from the  
11 National Registry of Food Safety Professionals; penalties"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 1, line 9, delete "sanitary code" and insert "Sanitary Code"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 1, line 16 after "for sale" delete the comma " , "

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 Delete page 2 and insert:

18 **"D. (1) An individual qualifying under the provisions of this Section shall**  
19 **register with the Department of Health and Hospitals on an annual basis.**

20 **(2) The Department of Health and Hospitals shall maintain an up-to-date public**  
21 **registry on the department's website.**

22 **E. An individual selling cookies and cakes from home for sale to the public shall**  
23 **be required to obtain a certificate from the National Registry of Food Safety**  
24 **Professionals.**

25 **F. (1) It shall be a misdemeanor for an individual to fail to register as required**  
26 **pursuant to this Section.**

27 **(2) Such misdemeanor shall be punishable upon conviction by a fine of not less**  
28 **than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars.**

29 **(3) Such misdemeanor shall be prosecuted by the district attorney of the judicial**  
30 **district in which the offender resides."**
