1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 32:412(L)" insert "and (M)" and after "R.S. 40:1321(L)" insert
3 "and (M)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "cards;" insert: "to authorize driver's licenses and special
6 identification cards that comply with federal REAL ID regulations in certain instances; to
7 provide for oversight and approval;"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S. 32:412(L)" insert "and (M)" and change "is" to "are"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 8, after "license;" insert "veteran designation; "situs inversus totalis"
12 designation; REAL ID security marking;"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, after line 19, insert:

15 "M.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Act No. 807 of the 2008 Regular
16 Session of the Legislature, the Department shall issue a license which bears a United
17 States Department of Homeland Security approved security marking reflecting that
18 such credential meets the standards of the REAL ID Act of 2005 upon the request
19 of any individual who is otherwise eligible to be issued a license pursuant to this
20 Chapter and who meets all the requirements of the United States Department of
21 Homeland Security for a REAL ID compliant credential.

22 (2) If the individual elects not to be issued a REAL ID compliant driver's
23 license, such license issued by the department shall indicate that the driver's license
24 is not accepted by federal agencies for official purposes in compliance with the
25 United States Department of Homeland Security rules and the words "Not for federal
26 identification" shall be printed on the license.

27 (3) The compliance with REAL ID authorized pursuant to this Subsection
28 shall be limited to those standards in effect as of January 31, 2013. Any subsequent
29 changes to the federal rules shall only be implemented after oversight and approval
30 by the House and Senate Committees on Transportation, Highways, and Public
31 Works."

3 which bears a United States Department of Homeland Security approved security
4 marking reflecting that such credential meets the standards of the REAL ID Act of
5 2005 upon the request of any individual who is otherwise eligible to be issued a
6 special identification card pursuant to this Chapter and who meets all the
7 requirements of the United States Department of Homeland Security for a REAL ID
8 compliant credential.

9 (2) If the individual elects not to be issued a REAL ID compliant special
10 identification card, such card issued by the department shall indicate that the special
11 identification card is not accepted by federal agencies for official purposes in
12 compliance with the United States Department of Homeland Security rules and the
13 words "Not for federal identification" shall be printed on the special identification
14 card.

15 (3) The compliance with REAL ID authorized pursuant to this Subsection
16 shall be limited to those standards in effect as of January 31, 2013. Any subsequent
17 changes to the federal rules shall only be implemented after oversight and approval
18 by the House and Senate Committees on Transportation, Highways, and Public
19 Works.

20 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2014."
